### Competition Eligibility

Please make sure you are aware of the details below and are eligible to claim these amazing prizes should you win.

- Entrants must be 21 years of age or older
- Entrants must be able to attend all mandatory course dates of the respective courses;

**-Level 3 Certificate for Forest School Leaders:** (21st, 22nd and 29th September, 6th and 13th October, 10th, 11th, 12th, 16th and 18th of November 2020)

**-Level 1 Award in Forest School Ethos and Principles:** 6th and 7th of July 2020

- Entrants must be able to meet the pre-course requirements;

#### **Level 3 Certificate for Forest School Leaders:**

- Have professional experience either working within education or working with children/young people/adults in the outdoors or nature conservation or outdoor education
- Have previously completed a level 3 qualification or equivalent

#### **Level 1 Award in Forest School Ethos and Principles:**

- No pre-course requirements

- Entrants must have access to a suitable group and site for the purpose of completing the Level 3 Certificate for Forest School Leaders (Planning and delivery of a "introduction to Forest School Programme)
- Enrolment and completion of both respective courses is subject to course terms and conditions which will be provided upon confirmation of winning (Terms and conditions can also be requested in advance by contacting [d.coleman@staffs-wildlife.org.uk](mailto:d.coleman@staffs-wildlife.org.uk))
- To complete the Level 1 course, entrants will need observe a qualified Level 3 Forest School Leader deliver a Forest School session.

- Entrants will only become recognised Forest School leaders (Level 3) and receive their accreditation once all aspects of the course are completed and portfolios have been successfully marked and passed through the quality assurance process.

- 3rd Prize winning entrant will have the choice of attending one of the following CPD events in 2020;
  - Working with Fire, Wed 17th June (10am – 3pm) at the Wolseley Centre
