Insects totally transform the way they look a number of times during their lifetime. Take a look at some extraordinary insects & the radical changes they go through.

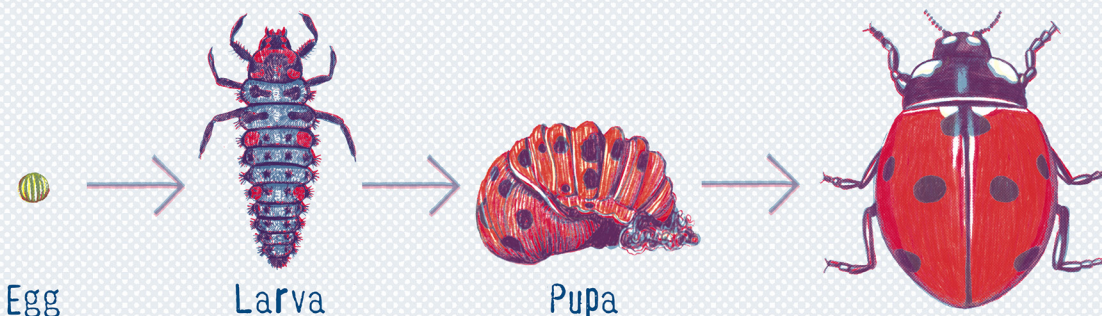
PEACOCK

COMPLETE METAMORPHOSIS

Many insects including beetles, bees, flies, ants, moths, butterflies & fleas go through 4 massive changes of appearance during their lifetime. The 3rd stage appears inactive, but inside its outer shell the insect is changing from larvae to adult.

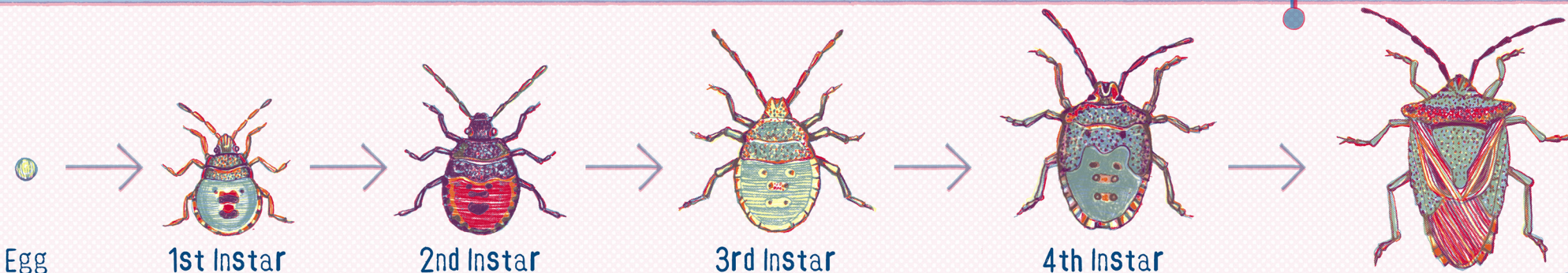

INCOMPLETE METAMORPHOSIS

Some insects including bugs, lice, grasshoppers & crickets change appearance many times before adulthood. An insect's hard shell does not grow, so when it gets too small, it splits & falls off to reveal a new, larger skin underneath. Each change is called an instar & can look very different from the one before.
